On site check-in and orientation for the District IV 4-H Nutrition Quiz Bowl will begin at 11:00 a.m. in Conference A (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor) of the Sam Rayburn Student Center on the campus of Texas A&M Commerce. The contest should begin at approximately 11:30 a.m.

To the best ability, accommodations will be made for those individuals who have conflicts with other district 4-H contests on this day.

There is no limit to the number of teams a county may enter. Age divisions are Junior, Intermediate, and Senior and consist of 3 or 4 members of the same age. Junior members will be allowed to move up to the intermediate age division in order to complete a team. Juniors and intermediates are not allowed to move up to the senior age division.

Each team must have an adult/coach on site during the contest. For all age divisions, this is a double-elimination tournament. First through fifth place team awards will be presented at the conclusion of the contest.
