What is Leader 4 Life?

The Leaders 4 Life Skill-A-Thon is a competition to challenge county teams in their **leadership skills**, knowledge of **parliamentary procedure**, and **service learning** activities. This contest involves three components:

⇒ Parliamentary Procedure Demonstration

- ⇒ Teams will have 15 minutes to review “mock” agenda and make a plan for their demonstration
- ⇒ Demonstration cannot be longer than 20 minutes—*time starts when gavel is tapped for meeting to start and ends when meeting is adjourned.*
- ⇒ Junior/Intermediate Team Required Procedures
 - Main Motion
 - Amend a Motion
 - Division (of the assembly)
 - Refer to a Committee
- ⇒ Senior Team Required Procedures
 - *All the above procedures, plus*
 - Lay on the table
 - Take from the table
 - **Withdraw a motion**

⇒ Question-and- Answer Session

- ⇒ 10 questions per team related to Parli Pro
- ⇒ Each member must answer one question
- ⇒ Individual team members cannot answer more than 3 questions

⇒ Seniors Only: Service Learning Interview and Interpretation Piece.

- ⇒ Teams will be interviewed about their service learning project

- ⇒ Two Division
 - ⇒ Junior and Intermediates will be combined
 - ⇒ Seniors
- ⇒ Teams need 4 to 6 members
- ⇒ Team roles:
 - ⇒ President
 - ⇒ Vice president
 - ⇒ Secretary
 - ⇒ Treasurer
 - ⇒ Plus two additional positions
- ⇒ Top three Senior teams will advance to the state contest held at Texas 4-H Roundup
